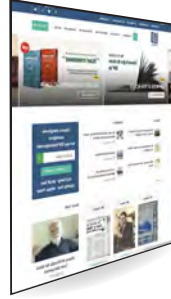

Scientific Studies Association's (ILEM) 9th Ordinary General Assembly was held. It was hosted by Maveria Education and Health Foundation on May 26, 2018. The Assembly started with the opening speech of the Chairman of the Executive Board after the quran tilawat.

In his speech, Mr. Güder stated that when they have taken over the task two years ago, their main goal was; "To deepen the current field of activities and increase their quality, improve the relations with our members, take steps in terms of internationalization, develop the current partnerships with different NGOs and complete the ongoing projects." 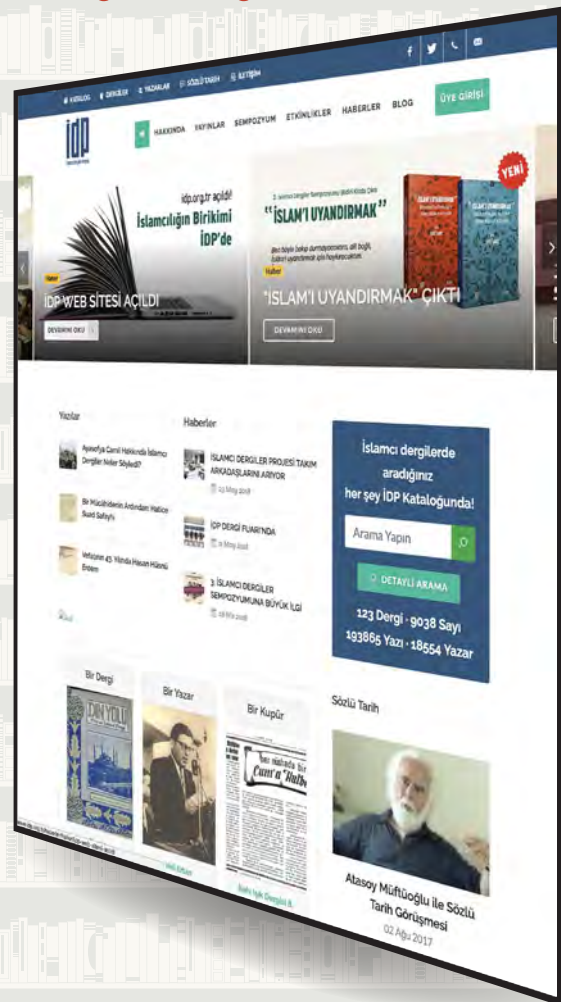


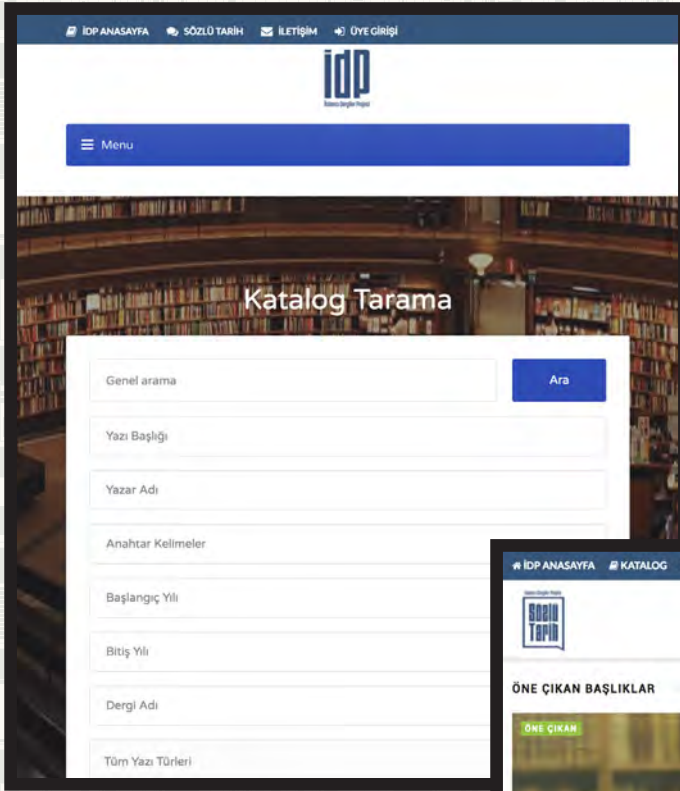
The Last Century of Islamic Thinking Emerges: IDP's Renewed Website Has Launched!

Digital Archive and IDP Catalogue

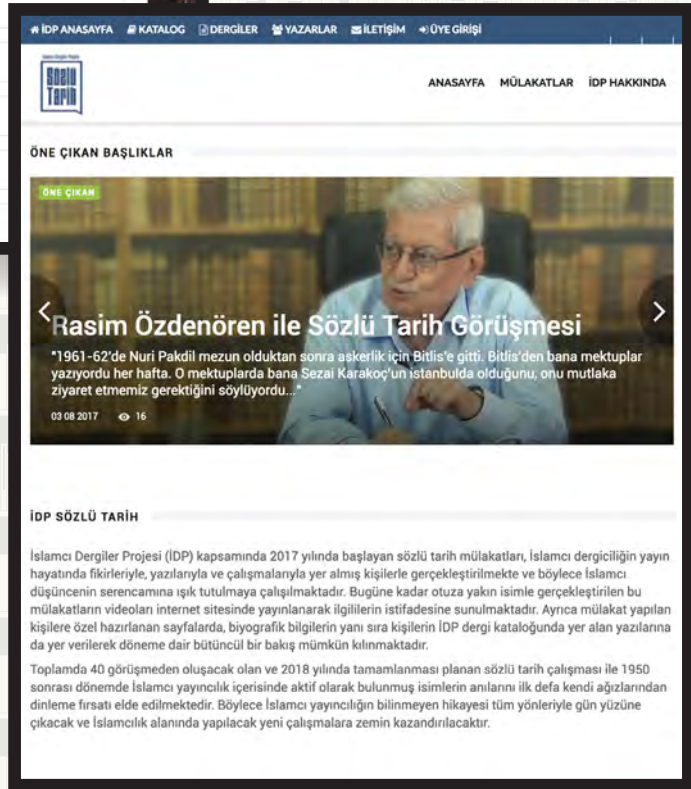

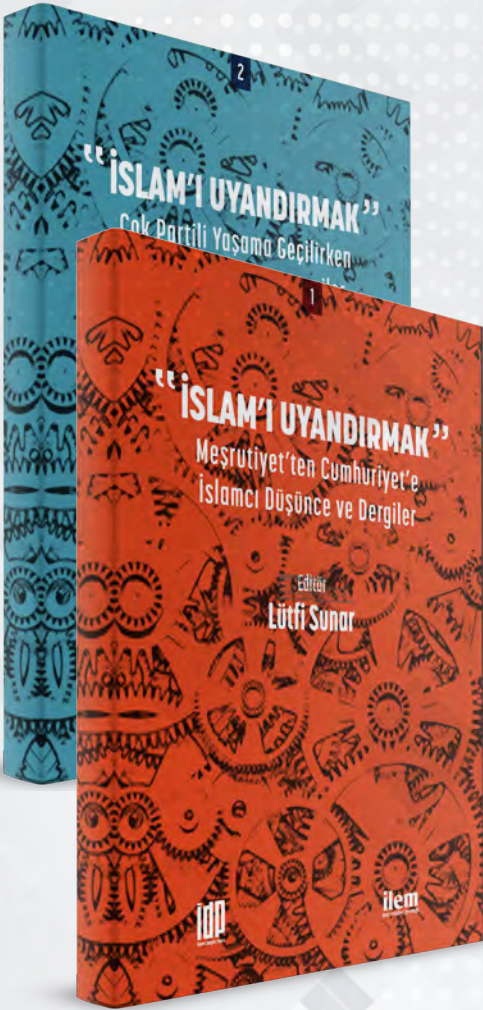
2nd Islamics Magazines Symposium papers were published as a 2-volume set. In the books, named after Mehmet Akif's poem "Hüsran", the first 50 years of Islamics evaluated from an expert point of view.

The book centers around the period from 1908 to 1960, which the idea of Islamics sprout and was shaped in the magazines for the first time, and it examines the fundamental dynamics, founding names and discussion areas of the important magazines of the period.

In this work, which contains the articles of academicians who specialize in the field of Islamics, close reading was carried out on names like Mehmet Akif, Eşref Edib, Bediüzzaman Said Nursi, Said Halim Paşa, Ahmet Hamdi Akseki, Ömer Rıza Doğrul, Şemseddin Günaltay, Emrullah Efendi, Abdurrahim Zapsu, Ziya Şakir, Osman Yüksel Serdengeçti who were related to the thought of Islamics during various periods.

The magazines like Sırât-ı Müstakîm, Sebilürreşad, Volkan, Teârûf-i Müslimîn, İslam Türk Mecmuası, Hareket, Serdengeçti, Hikmet, Ehl-i Sünnet, Cerîde-i İlmiyye, Hak, İslam'ın Nuru ve Selamet, which had important functions in the context of the formation, development and transition of the idea of Islamics, were taken into focus. The Islamics magazines, published between the years 1908-1960, were examined with a historical inquiry from a broad perspective, in order to show the specific breaking points, tendencies, continuity of the idea of Islamics and the relations with the other components of the society.



Two Awards for

ATLAS OF ISLAMIC THOUGHT

The Atlas of Islamic Thought, which continued to be of interest since the day it was published, was deemed worthy of two awards. It received the “Publishing Special Award” during the 36th “The Authors, Intellectuals and Artists of the Year” awards which was organized by the Turkish Authors’ Association (TYB) this year and it also received an award in the category of “Thought” during ESKADER 2017 Culture and Art Awards.

7th Turkey Graduate Studies Congress was held in Burdur!

This year's Turkey Graduate Studies Congress, where the academic community of Turkey comes together, was held at Mehmet Akif Ersoy University between 9-12 May 2018. First held in Konya, Turkey Graduate Studies Congress, which brings Turkish academic community together for the last seven years in an interdisciplinary platform, continued to do so this year as well.





Each year, the Congress brings academicians who perform their academic studies at the graduate level together, and this year it received 789 applications from 98 different universities. During the Congress of intense interest, over 130 different academics from 17 different academic disciplines have shared their academic knowledge in 32 different sessions. Academicians from various universities of Turkey participated in the Congress, which organized internationally and became a trademark in terms of contributions to academic knowledge sharing between disciplines, to listen the papers.

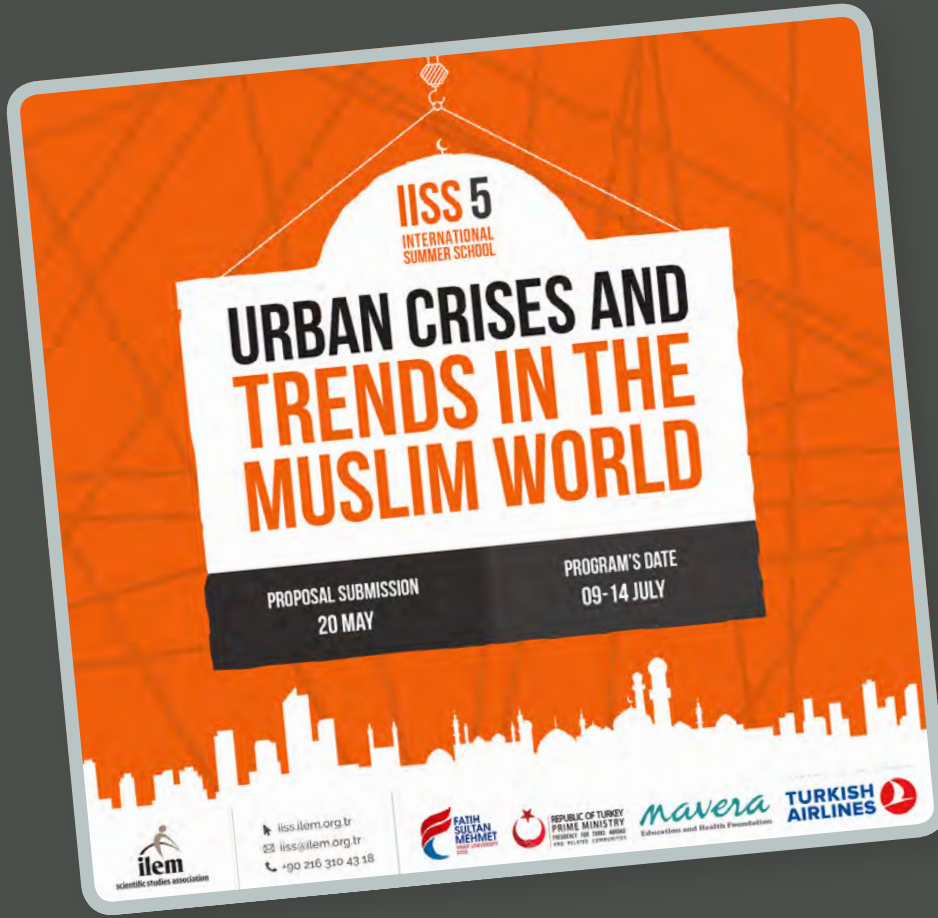

International ILEM Summer School to host architects and city planners from the Islamic world

Applications for the 5th International ILEM Summer School titled “Urban Crises and Tendencies in Islamic World” ended on June 1, 2018. From 27 different countries, 155 postgraduate and doctoral student applied to the program this year. After the past summer school programs, titled “Change in Islamic World in the 21th Century”, “State and Community in Islamic World”, “Social Justice and Poverty in the Islamic World” and “Reproduction of Knowledge in Islamic World: Methodological Perspectives”,

5th International ILEM Summer School’s main theme will be “Urban Crises and Tendencies in the Islamic World”. Prominent names like; Prof. Dr. Abdel Wahed Al-Wakil, Prof. Dr. Gulzar Haider, Prof. Dr. Jamel Akbar, Prof. Dr. Mustapha Ben-Hamouche, Doç. Dr. Alev Erkilet will be taking part in the summer school program which will be held in İstanbul on 9-14 July, with their lectures and presentations. During the 7-day summer school program, international students coming from abroad will also be hosted.

ILEM Summer Academy Begins

The applications of the ILEM Summer Academy, which we set out to be the bridge of knowledge from Istanbul to Anatolia, took place between April 25 to May 20. From 38

departments of 62 different universities, 335 undergraduate students applied to the program and 75 of them qualified.

While a strong literary tradition develops with the richness of the sources it feeds on, the way to understand and enjoy that tradition or literature is to recognize those mentioned sources and to have “intellectual knowledge” regarding that field.

And what is the role of the Qur'an in shaping our literature, or can it be mentioned that the Quran has a founding effect on Turkish literature? Can the Qur'an be considered as a source of both content and forms of Turkish literature? We tried to seek answers to all these questions in the Qur'an and Literary Seminars that we organized in the Spring period 2018. Also we've organized a series of long-term seminars starting from classical poetry to modern Turkish literature where we examine the language and declamation of Qur'an, its stance on poetry, its effects on language and mythology and transfer of the Qur'anic concepts and anecdotes to literature and the style of the representation. In this series, we aimed to fill a gap resulting from the lack of studies on the relation between Quran and literature, and to offer a large-scale study of the field. In this context, Mahmut Kaya with his

lecture titled "The Development Process of Islamic Literature with the Inspiration of Qur'an" was our guest on March 13 and carried out the first seminar of the series. Dursun Ali Tökel with his seminar titled "Qur'an as a Base Text of our Literature" led the 2nd leg of the seminar series on April 3. After Tökel, İsmail Güleç who was with us on April 24, gave his lecture titled "Poet and Poetry According to Qur'an". At the last stage of the seminar series, Berat Açı was with us. Açı gave his lecture titled "The Influence of Qur'an on the Formation of the Ottoman Poetry Aesthetics" on May 15.

During the seminar series, the influence of the Qur'an on the changes in literature, expression power of Qur'an in regards to comprehension of the poem and the poet and the effects on the formation of the Ottoman poetry were discussed extensively by academics.

Caliphate Workshop on the 500th Anniversary of the Transition of Caliphate to Ottoman Empire

Many prominent names who carried out extensive researches regarding the field were at the Workshop. During the workshop, which began with the speech of the chairman of the ILEM Süleyman Güder, Caliphate was evaluated in a wide perspective; from its emergence, to the perceptions in the idea of contemporary Islam.

Süleyman Güder, in his opening remarks, pointed out that there are two vicious cycles which clamps the discussions regarding caliphate. He stated that the first of these cycles is the discussion of whether the caliphate is Qurayshi or belongs to the House of Othman, and the second cycle is that the discussions are usually carried in a nostalgic atmosphere. Mr. Güder reminded that, even though the caliphate has a religious aspect, fundamentally it is an important position that has a political aspect and meaning. Mr. Güder stated that the caliphate is considered as an institution of the past and therefore whether if it still means something today or not is not being evaluated. "One of the sources of the problems

that the Islamic World is having today is the absence of this authority," he said in his lecture.

In the first session chaired by Mustafa Fayda; "Umayyad and Caliphate"

by Mustafa Sabri Küçükbaş, “Abbasids and Caliphate” by Casim Avcu, “Seljuks and Caliphate” by Hasan Hüseyin Adaloğlu and “Ottoman Caliphate” by Tuzan Buzpinar were facilitated.

During second session chaired by Asmi Özcan, where three papers were presented, lectures titled; “Concepts of Caliphate in Ottomans and Their Historical Processes” by Uğur Demir, “Concepts of Caliphate in Contemporary Thought of Islam: The example of Muhammed Hamidullah” by Abdulkadir Macit, “Reconsidering the Abolition of Caliphate” by Ali Satan were given.

After the session, workshop continued with the discussions and the inputs from the participants.

During the discussions, Chairman of the Organizing Committee Ali Satan pointed out that regarding the abolition of caliphate, rather than the internal dynamics and modernization, external

dynamics and security reasons played an important part. In addition, Azmi Özcan, who has many studies on the subject of caliphate, stated that the fact that the Republic Period academics approached our historical notions with a western literature caused the mistake of trying to understand caliphate with a similar understanding to Christian Papacy or spiritual leadership.

With this workshop, by examining the rich experiences of the caliphate which passed down to us through the different practices in Islamic history, ILEM is opening doors to new studies. All the data emerged from this workshop is considered to be collected in a book and presented to the benefit of scientific world.



The 6th Islamic Economics Workshop

was held in Istanbul University

The 6th Islamic Economics Workshop, which jointly organized by Research Center for Islamic Economics (IKAM), Turkish Entrepreneurship and Business Ethics Association (İGiAD), Scientific Studies Association (ILEM) and Center for Islamic Economics and Finance (İSİ-FAM), was hosted by Istanbul University. During the 3-day workshop, where many important discussions took place, 8 sessions and 1 panel were held.

AUTHORITY: O ye who believe! Obey Allah, and obey the Messenger, and those charged with authority among you. If ye differ in anything among yourselves, refer it to Allah and His Messenger, if ye do believe in Allah and the Last Day: That is best, and most suitable for final determination.



The sixth of the “Islamic Economics Workshop” which is one of the influential organizations in the field, where almost 100 academics from 10 different countries participated and 15 papers were presented and discussed, was held with the theme “Methodology in Islamic Economy”. Throughout the workshop, papers on the following subjects were presented; Islamic economical approach against the fundamental assumptions of modern economy, philosophical foundations of the Islamic economics methodology, economical approaches in Islamic thought, adaptation and implementation of fiqh method and traditional economic methodology to contemporary world, holistic use of fiqh and economy in Islamic economy, current methodology in Islamic economy discussions, theory-practice and relation to politics in Islamic economy.

In the 6th Islamic Economics Workshop, where a panel and 6 sessions were held, academics agreed that the Islamic economy is a social science and by being based on the fundamental texts of Islam, it aims to provide welfare to people. They’ve also stated that it is a unique economical system. Academics who presented papers in the workshop emphasised that the studies on Islamic economics methodology should increasingly continue. In the sessions it was also recorded that the Islamic economy addresses not only to Muslims, but to all people.



Hayrettin Karaman, who received the award for his contributions to the Islamic economy, couldn't participate to the program since he was out of town. Chairman of İKAM Lütfi Sunar, who presented the award to Mr. Karaman's son, Lütfullah Karaman, said that for over half a century, Mr. Karaman carried out the necessary initiatives regarding fiqh for the implementation of Islamic economy, both with his counseling activities and scientific studies, and played an important part in ensuring that the field is not restricted just to academic studies but it is implemented as well. ►

Spring Semester

Specialization Studies

280 applications were made for the ILEM Specialization Studies program which first started in the Spring Semester of 2012 with 17 programs. For the 13th period that took place in Spring Semester of 2018, we've received 322 applications. 190 graduate students regularly took part in ILEM Specialization Studies which consist of lectures, reading groups and workshops.

In addition to the workshops that took place, the possibility of benefiting from the knowledge of competent names through the conference series has emerged this semester. In the

community studies, the lectures that are opened by the lecturers Muhammed Demirel and Yusuf Kaya in the context of law and social class, have allowed new field of studies to be born. For the first time this year, with an active participatory group in the Methodology of History round table class, lecturers Teyfur Erdoğan and Abdülkadir Macit, revived a course which now carefully maintained by ILEM. While the Razi readings with the lecturer Eşref Altaş continue, the lectures given on the emergence of modern physics by Engin Koca, added another dimension to the Philosophy





studies made under ILEM's roof. Without decreasing its performance, The Politics Working Group has increased its accumulation with a very lively program with the students of Süleyman Güder, Asena Demirer and Vahdettin Işık. At the same time, Qur'an and Literary seminars series and Concept of Law Workshop have produced their first drafts. The Islamic Economics readings, organized in partnership

with IKAM, continue to produce its ground with theoretical and historical aspects.

In Search of Youth in the Modernization Era lecture led by Kurtuluş Öztürk, which is one of the most intriguing lectures of this semester, produced its medium with the participation of the young educator academics.

While ILEM is leaving six years behind, it will continue to be a perspective for the hundreds of thesis-paper studies it inspired and provided foundation.

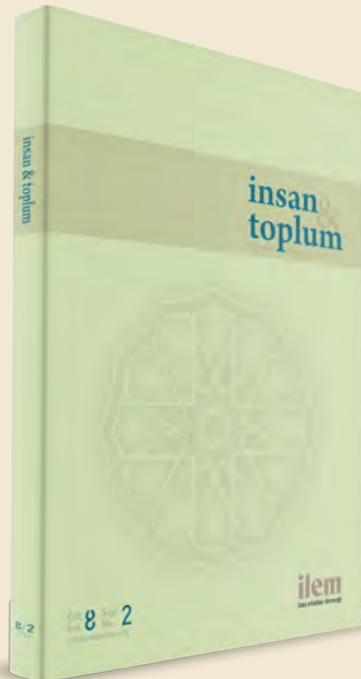
Volume 8, 1 and 2 of The Journal of the Humanity & Society are Out!

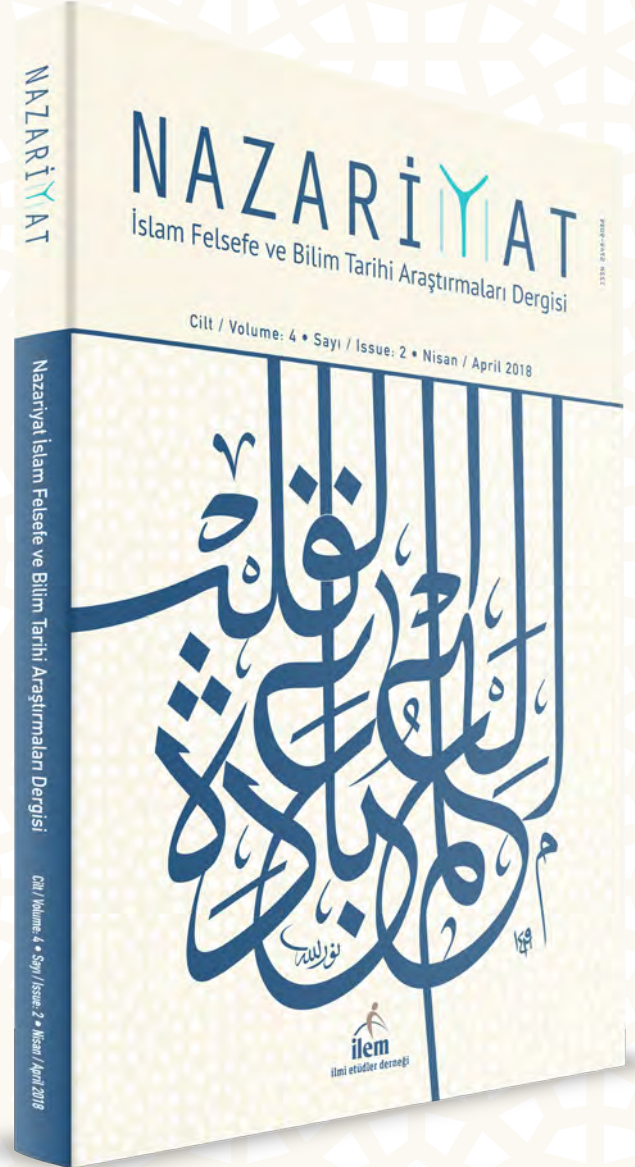
